- A financial designation (CPA) with senior level financial leadership experience in the corporate, public and/or non-profit sectors;

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- A legal, governance or policy background with an understanding of the BC Societies Act and the not for profit governance context;
- Broad based business or community experience with a passion for community living support and/or personal connection to our work.

Requirements

- The ability to attend quarterly board meetings, committee meetings between board meetings and periodic board events primarily during evenings and weekends. The minimum monthly commitment to board-related activities is approximately 6 hours.
- A respectful style and desire to work collaboratively with like-minded compassionate colleagues in an open, honest and productive manner for the benefit of our clients and in support of our staff.

NEXUS is committed to fostering a culture that values Diversity, Respect, Belonging and Choice, and our board operates in a non-hierarchical, open and inclusive manner.

Term of Appointment

Directors are expected to be able to commit to an initial term of term of two (2) years, with eligibility for re-appointment to a maximum of four (4) consecutive terms (eight years in total).
